**How to Apply:** Please read instructions carefully before filling online form. You may fill Online Application Form from Green Skill Development Programme Portal (<http://gsdp-envis.gov.in/Default3.aspx>). Applications received after last date i.e. **31 December 2021** will not be considered by screening committee.

**Selection of Candidates:** Screening Committee would screen all applications and list of candidates shortlisted for the interview will be uploaded on the ENVIS, WII website [www.wiienvis.nic.in](http://www.wiienvis.nic.in) (in latest news section). Date, venue and time of interview would be intimated separately to shortlisted candidates by the email. Interview will be conducted either in physical/ online mode. **No reimbursement will be provided for attending the interview in person.**

### Selection Criteria:

First preference would be given to applicants who are of lower income group, unemployed and residents of Uttarakhand & other neighboring states. Candidates should be physically fit to carry out field work in the forested areas.

### Course Fee:

No course fee will be charged, it is a FREE training programme (including boarding and lodging), sponsored by ENVIS Secretariat, Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India.

### Evaluation and Assessment:

The candidates will be assessed and evaluated based on their performances in both written and practical examinations. Certificates will only be issued to trainees after successful completion of the course.
